RUSHMORE ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL GUIDELINES REPEALED

Student Selection:

Students of high school age will be given first priority for enrollment in the school. High School age students who are behind in credits and who will not otherwise graduate with their age appropriate class will be considered first for enrollment in the Alternative School. These students will need to apply to the Principal or counselor. Eligible students will receive a packet of information and must make contact with the Rushmore Alternative School instructor within five (5) school days with the necessary documentation to be considered for enrollment or to be placed on any waiting list.

Freshmen will not be considered for the Rushmore Alternative School unless they are currently transferring from a "like" setting.

Adults wishing to complete the credits necessary to achieve their high school diploma will be given next priority for any open spots in the school. They need to make direct contact with the Alternative School instructor to obtain the necessary paperwork. Should a spot not be available they will be placed on the waiting list.

Priority, for those on the waiting list, will be given to those students who would be the most likely to complete their courses and graduate with their class. All others will be listed in order of received applications.

The high school principal will be the final determinant for mediation of any concerns with the Alternative School, including but not limited to enrollment, credits, and graduation.

Upon completion of the basic high school graduation requirements, the student will be awarded a Hill City High School diploma at the next regularly scheduled school board meeting.
